Question: What is it?

The first-ever ukulele festival at the 122-year-old Florida State Fair in Tampa presented by the Florida State Fair and the Tampa Bay Ukulele Society (TBUS). LUNA Guitars, Ukuleles and Percussion is the Ukulele Sponsor of Uka-PALOOZA!

It will happen Feb. 9, 2019, on the first Saturday of the fair which runs Feb. 7-18. Uke and family fun activities are scheduled 10am-4pm. A Performers Showcase with regional uke bands and Jam with James Hill is 4-7pm. The Night Concert with James Hill is from 8pm (doors open, festival seating) until 10pm.

Question: What is the cost?

Uka-PALOOZA! at the Florida State Fair, advance ticket: \$9 adult (12+) \$5 child (6-11)
